Quartermaster – Mike Hussar reported that he bought two shelving units to store Troop perishables and such. The committee approved up to \$200 for the purchase of a GPS unit by the Scoutmaster for troop use.

Program

- Klondike Derby sled construction – three are complete one equipped with wheels. Patrol equipment lists were given to the patrol leaders. Mike Hussar will be health officer for the District and Larry Zimbler will staff the lost city. We will stay in the Dining Hall with Troop 212 again this year. The SPLs from the two troops will work out the food split.
15 scouts for 1 or 2 patrols (depending on when scouts are done with basketball) are planning to attend.
- The pancake breakfast on Scout Sunday, February 5 will run from 7:30 to 9 and after the 11 am service until 1 pm. The troop will send a letter to Session asking to hold the breakfast. A cook and 6 scouts are needed at a minimum.
- Polar Bear Training has been cancelled due to lack of interest.
- The cabin has been reserved for February 17th through the 20th at Camp Tapico. This will be a family winter activity. This will be a family outing and parents and siblings are welcome. The cabin can sleep 30 and the first 30 sign ups will participate. Program is needed for Saturday.
- Blue Springs is on for the 4th and 5th of March. The fee will include gas for drivers and Saturday dinner.
- Amy Cohoon will chair Scouting for Food. The food bank needs help in the warehouse after the Scouting for Food pickup on the 18th.
- March 10 is the Troop 179 Lockin.
- There will be a meeting on the 15th of January to discuss crossover and the first year program. Mike Adams would like to prepare a syllabus for the program. Pack leaders will be invited.

Other Items

- February 10th is the deadline to sign up for Mackinac Island Service Troop. Scouts must be 13 years old and first class. There is a parent meeting the first of February.
- NYLT (youth leader training) for this year is filling up. Our troop could send 3 to 5 scouts. The Troop will pay half of the fee. The Scoutmaster will recruit scouts.
- District Pinewood Derby will be chaired by Dennis Weston. It will be held February 25th at FIS. The troop will sell concessions and car stands.
- Pinewood car stands sale at Pack 286 went well and they sold out of most types. Stock is low and Dennis Weston will set up work days for assembly. Doug Congdon will cut pieces.
- The Bylaws draft will be reviewed at the meeting February 8th.
