Program

- Scouting for Food is the 10th and 17th of March. We will meet at 9 am at the Church both Saturdays.
- The Tomahawk campsite is reserved for the 1st year and Hike-a-Thon campout. It is scheduled for two nights.
- Crossovers are uncertain this year Pack 212 will visit on the 19th. Pack schedules are as follows: 212 25th at Fenton Lakes Sportsman Club, 158 the 25th at the electrical union hall on Hill Road, 286 in March, 270 unknown. We may get up to 15 scouts and 2 or 3 adults.
- Dorchester show of interest will be out soon.

Other Items

- The Troop website host has been having problems. Mr. Zimbler reports that all servers are down. He says that tech support is nearly nonexistent and he has no confidence in the service. He suggested another service which offers website hosting and unlimited e-mail addresses for \$95 per year or \$142 for two years. It will take about two weeks to move everything to the new site from backups and be up again. Motion by Zimbler, seconded by D. Weston to approve up to \$200 for website costs, approved unanimously.
