- The committee discussed having a pool available for swim checks and pool night on a Monday before summer camp. Several alternatives were mentioned John Waters and Mike Hussar will check further.
- The committee approved the expenditure of approximately \$5 each for troop t-shirts to be distributed in conjunction with summer camp.
