

Bike Safety Rules

• **Bikes are not to be used during any camp wide event. Bikes may be parked at the bike racks located by the OA Pavilion and the Boating Area.**

• Bike Safety Orientation must be completed prior to renting a bike or using a personal bike on camp.

• Bikes must have the owner's name and troop number affixed to the bike, preferable attached to the center bar of the bike.

• Approved helmets only are required to be worn by all those riding bikes. Troop numbers must be affixed to the helmet in 2-inch high numbers.

• Bikes are limited to camp roads only.

• Bikes are not to be operated during hours of darkness.

• Bikes cannot be ridden off camp unless the Camp Director or his designated representative grants permission.

• Bike riders must insure they park their bikes in designated places only. If a bike is parked in a place that impedes the flow of traffic, it will be moved and impounded for 24 hours by the Ranger Section.

• Do not operate bikes in program areas or campsites.

• Bike riders must announce their presence when approaching walkers.

• The Tall Pine Council is not responsible for damage or loss of personal bikes helmets or equipment. **Lock your bike.**

• Tapico Bikes are considered camp equipment. **Any damage to a camp bike will be considered the responsibility of the Troop.**

• **Violation of bike safety rules will be grounds for loss of biking privileges.**
