ALWAYS BRING OUTER WEAR AND CLOTHING APPROPRIATE FOR THE WEATHER AND ALWAYS BRING RAIN GEAR, REGARDLESS OF THE FORECAST. ALSO CONSIDER WATERPROOF BOOTS / SHOES AND GLOVES - BE PREPARED FOR THE CONDITIONS AND REMEMBER THAT EVENINGS AND NIGHTS CAN BE COLD EVEN FOLLOWING WARM DAYS.

FOR TENT CAMPOUTS - THE TROOP OR SUMMER CAMP WILL PROVIDE ALL TENTS

- Personal First Aid Kit - see 2nd Class Requirement for first aid
- Poncho / Rain gear
- 1 Complete Change of Clothing for **each night** out
- Boy Scout Handbook
- Full Scout Uniform (official uniform shirt, pants, belt, socks & hat)
- Field Activity Uniform – Scout T-SHIRT, shorts and hat - weather permitting
- Pajamas or something to change into for bed
- Sleeping Bag and 1 blanket or 2-3 blankets
- Ground Cloth
- Ground Pad/Sleeping Pad
- Pillow
- Flashlight - extra batteries
- Insect repellent - pump or lotion - no aerosol sprays of any kind!
- mosquito netting for long term camps
- Toilet Articles - soap, towel, washcloth, comb, toothbrush and toothpaste and whatever else you might need
- Canteen/water bottle
- **Eating utensils; knife, fork, spoon, hot/cold cup, plate and bowl –**
YOU WILL NOT NEED INDIVIDUAL COOKING EQUIPMENT
- Scout Knife - if you have your Tote-N-Chip Card (folding blade <= 3")
- Compass
