- **Email Addresses-last call**

Some families do not have an Internet account and handouts and telephone calls will continue to be utilized to pass on information to all families. - **Final Troop 219 for 2000-2001 Scout Year**

Monday, June 11, 2001 is the final meeting for the Troop 219 2000-2001 Scout year. The next regular troop meeting will be Monday, September 10, 2001 and will begin the 2001-2002 Scout year.

- **Pre-Summer Camp Campout AND Final Court of Honor for 2000-2001**

There will be a campout on the weekend of June 15-17, 2001. This will be held at Camp Holaka in Lapeer. We will be camping on Webelos Hill. While this campout is aimed primarily at those Scouts and adults attending summer camp this year all Scouts are invited and encouraged to attend.

**This campout is a required activity for Scouts (and adults) attending summer camp this year.**

**If you will not be able to attend this campout you need to talk to the Scoutmaster, Mr. Zimpler before the meeting date.**

There will also be a formal Court of Honor on Saturday evening. Families are invited to the Court of Honor, which will start at 8:00 P.M. Families are also invited out for dinner with the Scouts on Saturday before the Court of Honor. Dinner will be at 6:00 P.M. Family members should plan on a bringing a lawn chair and insect repellent. Camp Holaka does have MOSQUITOES.

We will depart for the campout from the southwest corner of the K-Mart parking lot on Friday evening at 6:00 P.M.

We will return to the K-Mart parking lot at noon on Sunday. Please be on time to pick up your Scout. You should have dinner before we depart for camp Friday evening.

The cost of the campout will be \$18.00. A Permission Slip and Health Form was distributed as part of Handout No. 28. Your forms and payment were due in tonight, Monday, June 11, 2001.

- **SMJLT Session Rescheduled**

SMJLT had to be rescheduled due to a poor turnout of newly elected or reelected junior leaders. The new date is Saturday, June 23, 2001. It will run from 9:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. and will be held at the Presbyterian Church. Lunch is provided as part of the program. There is no cost to participate. Part of your commitment as an elected junior leader is to attend the next scheduled SMJLT session after you are elected.

They should include a current picture of the Scout and may be a school picture or one taken of the Scout for any purpose. The completed and/or updated forms should be returned on or before the night of the Summer Camp Parent and Participant Meeting on Monday, June 25, 2001.

● **Fenton Fourth of July Parade**

If you are going to be home on the Fourth of July please remember that Troop 219 has the tradition of marching in the Fenton Freedom Festival parade. This parade has a different route and is a much more lively parade than the Memorial Day Parade but that is due to the different reasons of the day being celebrated. This parade starts at 10 A.M. on July 4 and we are usually done by noon. We will meet at the church parking lot **at 8:30 A.M.** for juice or apple cider and donuts and some last minute practice and to line up everyone so that we look sharp and THEN we will go to the staging area by Fenton Middle School between 9:15 and 9:30 A.M.

Your full Scout uniform is required including an **approved** Scout hat.

**PLEASE** plan on participating in this parade if you are in the area.
