### • Upcoming Due Dates and Activities

#### Order of the Arrow Spring Conclave

The 2007 Spring Conclave will be held at Camp Tapico and will begin on Friday, May 18, 2007 and will end on Sunday, May 20, 2007. If you are an Arrowman and plan on attending please see Mr. Hussar, Mr. Cox, or Mr. Miller for additional information. If you are a newly elected Ordeal Candidate then see one of the adults and also talk to Matt Rybar for additional information. Ordeal Members may seal their membership and become Brotherhood Members if you have been in the Lodge at least 10 months. That process takes place at the Conclave.

#### Memorial Day Parade

All Scouts are expected to participate in this parade, in a full Scout uniform, from hat to socks with everything else in between (and shoes), if your family is in town.

We will participate in the City of Fenton Memorial Day Parade. It will be held on Monday, May 28, 2007. We will meet at the church at 8:30 A.M. for some LIGHT refreshments and a little bit of final marching practice and then proceed over to the Fenton Community Center to take our place for the 10:00 A.M. parade. All activities at the cemetery should be over by 11:30 A.M. Scouts may be picked up there or at the church after we walk back there. **DO NOT TRY TO DRIVE INTO THE CEMETERY.**

#### Pre-Summer Camp Campout and Court of Honor

The Pre-Summer Camp Campout, mandatory for ALL Scouts and adults going to summer camp with the troop, is scheduled for Friday, June 15-Sunday, June 17, 2007. Page 3 is the Permission Slip and Health Form to be returned by Monday, June 4, 2007 **NO FEES APPLY.** We will have our third and final Formal Court of Honor, for the 2006-2007 Scout year, after dinner on Saturday evening. Families are invited out for dinner but please let us know if you will be coming out for dinner. The Court of Honor will be held in the Chapel near Webelos Hill if it is available that evening and will begin at 7:30 P.M. We will have a campfire after the Court of Honor if families wish to stay but they need to bring lawn or folding chairs AND insect repellent.

Also during this weekend Mr. Zimble will be conducting the Scoutmaster Junior Leader Training program for all returning, or recently elected, junior leaders in the troop. If you are not going to summer camp this year you must still attend the training which will run from 10:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. on Saturday.
