Summer Camp Swim Checks--REMINDER

Holly High School has open swim on Wednesday and Friday evenings. Summer camp swim checks will be conducted on Wednesday, June 13, 2007. Arrive at 7:00 P.M. but not later than 8:15 P.M. The cost is \$2 per person, and people 14 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

*** To be a #3 swimmer you must jump into water over your head, return to the surface and swim 75 yards freestyle (crawl stroke) or breast stroke or sidestroke or any combination of those strokes then swim 25 yards using the elementary backstroke (resting backstroke) and then float on your back for 1 minute. The 100 yard swim must be done continuously. ** A #2 swimmer must jump into water over their head, surface, swim 25 feet and then return to the starting point.

* A #1 swimmer is a non-swimmer. There is no test for a non-swimmer.
