### • **Scoutmaster Junior Leader Training**

This training will take place on this Saturday, April 12, 2008. If you are a newly elected Junior Leader or a returning Junior Leader then you are expected to be in attendance. The Training will take place from 9 A.M. until 2:00 P.M. You should be in full uniform and bring your Boy Scout Handbook and any questions you might have. Lunch will be provided.

### • **Red Cross CPR and First Aid**

Mr. Hussar is a Red Cross instructor and is offering an opportunity for Scouts and parents to learn CPR and First Aid. CPR is required for several merit badges and is an important skill to learn. The first aid class will be in more depth than the first year Scout program. CPR Training will run from 7:00-9:00 P.M. on Monday, April 7 and Monday, April 14. First Aid Training will run from 7:00-9:00 P.M. on Monday, April 7 and Monday, April 21, 2008. You need to attend all three sessions to be able to complete both Adult CPR and Standard First Aid. The cost for this training includes Red Cross Certification. Adult CPR is \$17.00 and with First Aid will be a total of \$24.00.

### • **District Roundtable, OA Chapter Meeting and Troop Committee Meeting**

The next District Roundtable will be held on Thursday, April 10, 2008. The meeting will take place at 7 P.M. at Fenton Road Baptist Church. This is for unit leaders, committee chairman and committee members who want to stay on top of District information and possibly even pick up some ideas for outings and activities. The OA Chapter Meeting is held at this same time.

The next Troop Committee Meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 16, 2008. These are held at the church and start at 7:00 P.M. They usually last one and one half hours.
