• **Summer Camp Health Forms and Troop 219 Child ID Forms**

The new Health Forms are on the web and available through Mr. Hussar, Mr. Cox or Mr. Miller. If you are attending summer camp this year they must be completed and returned no later than the June 23 Court of Honor and Summer Camp Parent/Participant Meeting. If you are going to insert a Sports Physical or page three from your old Health Form make sure the doctor signed it on or after July 12, 2005. Include the dates for your immunizations and the date of your last tetanus shot if you know it. Adults over age 40 need to complete a new physical form each year. The Adult Health Form is also new so make sure you get one from me if you are attending summer camp this year.

CHILD ID FORMS: We are asking for a new CHILD ID FORM each year now. Please complete and return this form by our last meeting in June, with a current photograph attached.

• **Troop Committee Meeting**

The next Troop Committee Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 21, 2008. These are held at the church and start at 7:00 P.M. and are over by 8:30 P.M.

• **Order of the Arrow Spring Conclave**

The Order of the Arrow Spring Conclave will be held the weekend of May 16-May 18, 2008. If you were nominated and elected into the Order of the Arrow you have one of two conclaves to seal your Ordeal Membership. This is the first opportunity and the second one will be in September during the Fall Conclave. Ordeal Members should have received an information package from the Lodge so that you will know how to prepare. We usually try to carpool as much as possible for this trip due to the long distance.

• **Memorial Day**

The Fenton Memorial Day Parade takes place at 10:00 A.M. on Monday, May 26, 2008. We will participate as a marching unit again and this year it is our responsibility,

and honor, to perform the flag ceremony at the Cemetery. We will meet at the church at 8:30 A.M. in full uniform, official Scout hat down to the socks with everything between included.

- **Fenton Relay for Life**

LOCATION: Lake Fenton Middle School. The Fenton Relay for Life Committee has asked for help on Friday, June 13 with an official flag raising ceremony and Pledge of Allegiance. We have also been asked to be available throughout the evening/night and then on Saturday until 3:00 P.M. to help with cleanup after the relay ends at 2:00 P.M. **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** We have been invited to spend the night on Friday, June 13, 2008. Arrival time is noon on Friday. There are activities planned for all night so bed could be an option.

The official flag ceremony opening will be performed by the Scouts at 2:00 P.M. I am looking for 6-8 Scouts who would be willing to do whatever is asked of us during the time we are there. This will be a tent campout for as and a pancake breakfast will be provided. As the events wind down on Saturday we will help with clean up and possibly taking down their tents and equipment. SPL Andrew Weston has told me that we will not be available that weekend. ASPL Jordan Dagenais will be attending NYLT beginning on Sunday and may not be available. I have not yet discussed this with him. I also have not talked with ASPL Max McDonald yet about his availability.
